SUB.: AMENDEMENT IN AFFILIATION BYE-LAWS OF THE BOARD - reg

Consequent upon the recommendations of Affiliation Committee in its meetings held on 07.12.2017 and subsequent ratification by the Governing Body in its meeting dated 18.12.2017, the following amendment in Affiliation Byelaws has been made by the Board:

1. AFFILIATION FEES (Appendix-II):

Affiliation fees as per Appendix-II of Affiliation Bye-Laws- The revised schedule of affiliation fees payable under various categories duly amended is attached with this notification. The amended schedule will be applicable with effect from the applications called for session 2019-20.

2. RESERVE FUND (Rule 14.2, Chapter-II)

Existing provision as per Rule 14.2 of Affiliation Bye-Laws.

Reserve Fund shall be maintained in the joint names of the Manager of the school concerned and the Secretary of the Board in a scheduled Bank. In case of institution receiving grant in aid or in case the School Education Act of the State/UT so prescribes, the reserve fund shall be maintained in the joint names of the Manager of the school and the Director or Education of the State/Union Territory concerned. The interest accruing out of the deposit of reserve fund made by the institution at the time of affiliation/ extension of affiliation be not withdrawn by the management under any circumstances what so ever.

Amended provision as per Rule 14.2 of Affiliation Bye-Laws.

Reserve Fund shall be maintained in the joint name of the Principal of the school and Managing Trustee/ Member of the Society/Trust/ Company etc. running the school concerned in a scheduled Bank. In case of institution receiving grant in aid or in case the School Education Act of the State/UT so prescribes, the reserve fund shall be maintained as prescribed in the rules/conditions of the concerned state. The interest accruing out of the deposit of reserve fund made by the institution at the time of affiliation/ extension of affiliation shall not be withdrawn by the management under any circumstances what so ever.

3. TIME PERIOD FOR REPRESENTATION AGAINST COMMUNICATION OF DECISION TO THE SCHOOL (Rule 15.6, Chapter-III):

Existing provision as per Rule 15 (6) of Affiliation Bye-Laws.

Any representation against the decision of the Board on scrutiny of application and inspection report shall be submitted within three months of communication of decision to the school.

Application of a school rejected after considering the representation, may apply afresh with prescribed fee subject to fulfilling the norms of affiliation given in Chapter II and the application will be considered against the academic session for which it is registered.

The school may seek refund of application fee after deduction of 50 per cent of fee as processing charges against rejection of application on scrutiny without inspection of the school within one year of communication of decision.

Amended provision as per Rule 15 (6) of Affiliation Bye-Laws.

Any representation against the decision of the Board on scrutiny of application and inspection report shall be submitted within one month of communication of decision to the school.

Application of a school rejected after considering the representation, may apply afresh with prescribed fee subject to fulfilling the norms of affiliation given in Chapter II and the application will be considered against the academic session for which it is registered.

The school may seek refund of application fee after deduction of 50 per cent of fee as processing charges against rejection of application on scrutiny without inspection of the school within one year of communication of decision.

4. Amendment of Provision of Permanent Affiliation to the schools

As per existing provisions contained in Chapter-II of Affiliation Bye-Laws, the schools can be considered for Permanent Affiliation {Rule 3.2(v) and 3.3(C)} subject to fulfilment of certain conditions. The Board has decided to discontinue the provisions of Permanent Affiliation as contained in the Affiliation Bye-Laws. All the provisions express or implied, contained in the Affiliation Bye-Laws in respect of the permanently affiliated schools stand amended to the effect that the Rules applicable to provisionally affiliated schools will apply to all these schools mutatis- mutandis and there will be no separate provisions for permanent affiliation and schools such affiliated.

All schools affiliated permanently with the Board will be considered as provisionally affiliated at par with other affiliated schools and will apply for extension of affiliation accordingly within the prescribed period with effect from the date of issue of this notification.

All the Heads of Schools are advised to take note of the above and also bring it to the knowledge of School Managing Committee.

These issues with the approval of the Competent Authority of the Board.
