## SUB: JEE Advanced - facilities for practical training for online examination-reg

As you are aware that the Government of India has decided to move to online mode of examination for JEE (Advanced) from the year 2018 onwards. Required infrastructure is being prepared in this connection. However, in order to alleviate apprehensions on the part of rural students, the assistance of all the affiliated schools is solicited by the Board.

Accordingly all the affiliated schools are hereby directed to allow its students access to the computer lab to take a mock test provided online by IIT-Kanpur between 1<sup>st</sup> May to 15<sup>th</sup> May 2018. This facility may be extended to the students who are qualified to write JEE (Advanced) examination only. During this period suitable assistance may also be provided to the students in case they require any clarifications on using the computer for answering the questions.

The schools are directed to be careful while allowing access to the candidates inside the school and take all precautionary measures to ensure the safety and security of the children studying in the school and attending classes on these days. All precautionary measures as given in Circular No.19 /2017 dated 12.09.2017 may be strictly adhered to.

The schools must also take care that if the school is an evaluation centre, then the process of evaluation must not be affected in any way by these arrangements and full secrecy, as required for evaluation, is maintained. It should be ensured that laboratories used for evaluation purpose are not used for the mock tests.

The directions may be adhered to meticulously, any violation will result in action in the light of the provisions contained in clause 17.2(a)(xi) of the Affiliation Bye –Laws.
